# MITACS-Accelerate

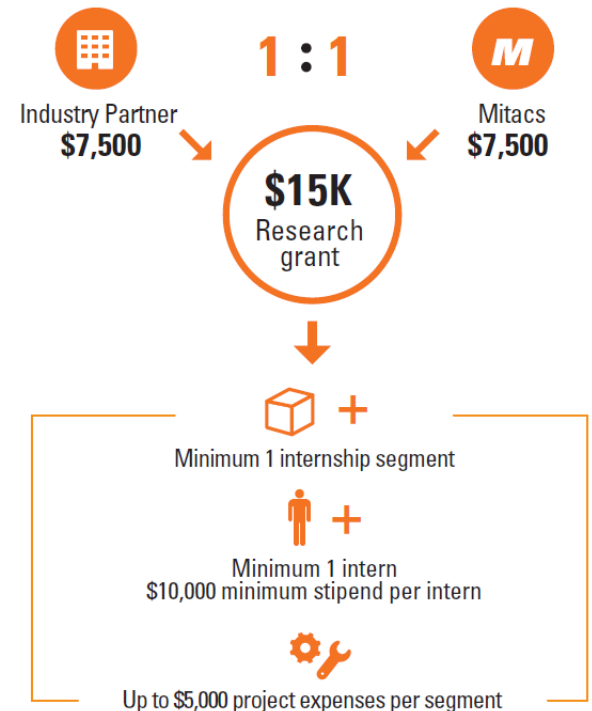
- Government + Industry Partnership
- Paired with many Canadian Universities
- Non-Canadian graduate students and Post-Doctoral fellows permitted
- Internships are renewable
- Student must spend 50% of time with company

## Accelerate Standard

### Scalable in 4 month internship segments

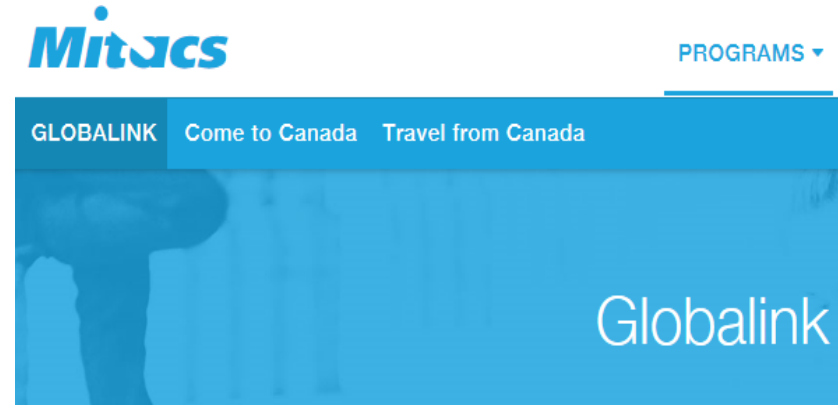
- ✓ Projects can range from a single four-month internship segment to multiple segments combined together to accommodate longer projects
- ✓ Cost-shared with Mitacs matching 1:1 the industry partner contribution



# MITACS-Globalink

- Globalink Research Program
- 12 week internship at a Canadian University
- Undergraduate students eligible from : Australia, Brazil, France, China, Germany, India, Mexico, Saudi Arabia, Tunisia, or Ukraine
- Application deadline each year
  - 2018 call opens in July
- Also allows students to return to Canada to complete further graduate degrees
- 2015-750 undergraduate interns were accepted

# Collaborative Agreement

- Partnership where AAFC and other organization share knowledge and expertise
  - Eg. Canadian germplasm sent to a location to be evaluated in a novel way (stripe rust, novel abiotic stress testing)
- Intern sent to Canada to learn a skill or complete research in a lab at Lethbridge
  - Applied studies student (affiliated with a University)
  - Visiting student agreement (affiliated with a University)
  - Visiting student agreement with AAFC
