



Hello Triticale researchers,

The 10th International Triticale Symposium will take place in Lethbridge, Alberta, Canada from July 15-July 18, 2019. We look forward to many of you joining us to share research results, ideas and form new collaborations.

The conference will take place at The Sandman Signature-Lethbridge Lodge, in Lethbridge, AB. There are rooms blocked off for conference attendees and the approximate cost of the hotel room is \$130 CDN per night.

Conference fees are as follows:

Early registration (Before May 31): \$ 450 CDN

Regular registration (After May 31): \$ 550 CDN

Early student registration: \$ 350 CDN

Full student registration: \$ 450 CDN

* Students must show proof of enrollment *via* active student card

Tuesday July 16: Breakfast, lunch, dinner and coffee breaks

Wednesday July 17: Breakfast, lunch, banquet dinner and coffee breaks

There will be space for 56 travellers. Please note that all participants will be responsible for **arranging their own travel to their home country from Saskatoon.**
